For Young Children- Infants to Age 6

CIRCLE OF SONG- infants to age 5 with adult

Circle of Song is a monthly family sing-a-long. The lively sessions include live guitar, dancing with colorful silks, storytelling and playing percussion instruments from around the world.

LITTLE SPROUTS- 18 months to 3 years with adult

Our Mommy & Me, led by director, Susan Caruso, introduces children and their parents to the basics of early cooperative play and problem solving skills. During the adult discussions, Susan supports parents as they develop their own parenting styles. Little Sprouts families build lasting friendships as they learn and grow together. A great introduction to the Sunflower community!

SEEDLINGS- ages 2 ½ to 6

Seedlings is our parent cooperative alternative to pre-school. The focus is on experiential learning and nurturing social emotional intelligence through the arts. Seedlings offers a rich environment for language and literacy development and teaching peaceful problem solving skills. NEW! DREAMS FOR SPECIAL NEEDS- ages 3-5 with an adult

A unique and integrative mommy and me class for children with special developmental needs ages 3 to 5 years old and their parents. This class provides interactive movement and music and an opportunity to network and connect with others in a child-friendly atmosphere. Parents will receive support, immediate observational feedback and suggestions about their child's social skills, language development, and emotional and cognitive functioning. Michele Iemolo facilitates, drawing on her extensive experience as a behavior analyst for children.

For Older Children- Ages 5 to 10

EXPLORERS- ages 6-10

The perfect after school program! Children discover their passions, develop social skills and learn to value their time by choosing activities wisely. Suzanne Snider and Susan Caruso offer a safe, nurturing environment for the children to interact with peers as they engage in science, building, art, music and storytelling projects.

NEW! EXPLORE A STORY- ages 5-8

Welcome master storyteller Mij Byram and her Explore a Story program!

This wonderful program allows children to make storytelling their own with unique characters, conflicts and alternate endings. They can be totally creative while developing higher thinking skills and asking questions as a way of learning.

Working toward a spring performance, this closely knit group brings characters to life, argues over the meaning of a scene, wallows in the wonderful language, explores shared emotions, improvises on themes and in the midst of all the fun develops a passionate love and understanding of Shakespeare! Students can come as early as 4:00 for small groups and individual scenes. Regular class time is 5:00 to 7:00. Parents are coordinated to provide pasta or soup dinners with salad for the group.

TEEN IMPROV- ages 13- 18

Liberate your imagination! Have fun with theatre games! Develop your creative impulses and intuition. Working together each teen will gain confidence in their own unique voice, understanding their importance not only as individuals but also as integral members of the group. A great way to start the weekend!

SHAKESPEARE FOR EVERYONE- ages 10- 18

Sponsored by TARGET and the Junior League of Boca Raton, this company of diverse actors presents free community performances of exciting action scenes and one hour versions of "A Comedy of Errors" or "A Midsummer Night's Dream" in parks, schools, libraries and senior centers. The students bring Shakespeare to those who might not otherwise see a live play.

DIRECTIONS:

We are located in the building (known as the RE Wing) off the playground at the back of the Unitarian Universalist Fellowship of Boca Raton.

From I-95 exit Glades Road west. Travel approximately 1 1/2 miles to Saint Andrews Blvd. and turn right (north). The Fellowship is just north of Glades on the west side of Saint Andrews directly across from the Pine Crest School. Park in the rear of the building and enter through the playground.

POLICIES:

- Always call if you need to miss a class. We worry!
- Diapers, food etc. - Please do not put soiled diapers in the rest room trash cans. Let a teacher know that you are putting it in one of our trash cans or take it with you! Food is only allowed in the playground area outside of classes.
- **We are a Nut Free facility- no nuts or nut products in any foods are allowed to pass through our gate.**
- Playground clean up- Help us keep our areas clean and neat. If your child stays to play after class please put away toys and throw away any trash so the facility is ready for the next class.
